

Greenwood Place Update - Dec 2015



We are pleased to update you that we have recently appointed Clifford Devlin as the demolition contractor for Greenwood Place and work to demolish the existing buildings on the site of the new community resource centre (25-37 Greenwood Place) will start in early 2016. This will last for approximately 12 weeks.

Once the site has been cleared, we can start working on the new community centre. The Design and Build contract for Greenwood Place is split into two phases and we have awarded phase one of this contract to Kier Construction London Ltd. You may not see much happening straight away, but Kier will be working hard to get the site ready for when building can start (phase two).

The facilities at the new community resource centre at Greenwood Place will include:

- Camden's first ever Centre for Independent Living (CIL)– supporting disabled people in Camden to live more independently
- A hydrotherapy pool within the centre which will benefit people with a range of physical disabilities and complex needs
- Spaces for services supporting people with dementia, mental ill health, learning disabilities, profound and multiple learning disabilities and autism.
- Private meetings spaces for information, advice, counselling and health appointments.
- Space for physiotherapy and occupational therapy
- Fully accessible flexible activity spaces, to include; an art room, an IT suite, a sound / music room, a large ground floor room with a sprung floor, suitable for exercise classes or events, amongst others
- A café, training kitchen and catering facilities
